- I. Welcome and Call to Order by Dr. Coon and Chip Payne
- II. Dean Jackson will present next month. He had a meeting at the District Office.
- III. We need a copy of the bylaws for the SIC notebook kept at the front desk of MGM.
- IV. SIC Elections will be held in May. We will need to elect three members. Tara Black, Ann Marie Green, and Lara Matthews will roll off at the end of this school year. We discussed making nominations via Survey Monkey. An announcement about nominations and elections will be emailed on Friday, May 3rd and on the School Messenger on Sunday, May 5. Nominations will be accepted beginning on Monday, May 6. Voting will begin on May 20 and end on May 24. Voting will be done electronically via Survey Monkey and paper ballots.
