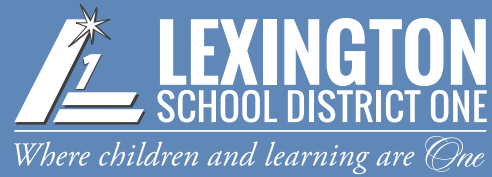

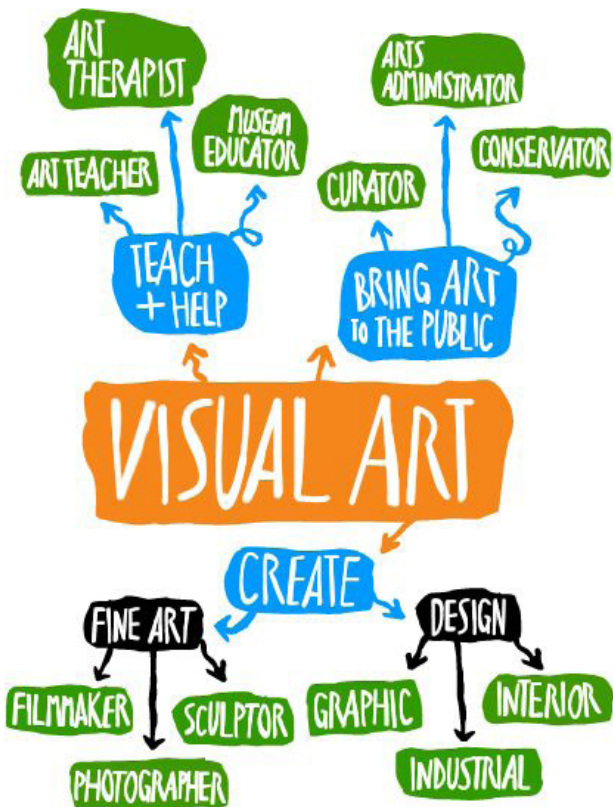


Lex1Take1 Arts Camp

Lex1Take1 is a visual, performing and creative writing arts camp for rising 7-9th grade students. During this 3.5 day camp, they will explore and create performances, both live and through video technology, using research and creative writing, inspired by visual arts. They will also have an opportunity to create sets and props as well as write scripts. An arts inspired field trip and guest speakers will keep the students engaged through hands-on, interactive activities.
